FRAINING COURSE

A 6-day training course for 22 participants (youth/social workers, facilitators, activists, artists...) of 7 partner countries to address topics and practices of graphic and visual facilitation, personal and social identities, participation and recovery of public spaces, artivism and social change through self-expression.

Patterns repeating at scale: shapes, patterns, symbols fundamental to our universe - what we practice at a small scale in our learning environments, we can reverberate to the largest scale of social change.

Co-construction of collective knowledge, exploration of concepts of "emergent strategy", identity and self-expression, symbolism and creativity in private and public domains, through participatory non-formal educational methods, learning by doing, community living, artistic and playful tools.
