

- To better understand the interconnected systems of oppression and current polycrisis through intercultural learning and non formal education

We believe in learning holistically (including the emotional, embodied, intellectual and spiritual) and experientially.


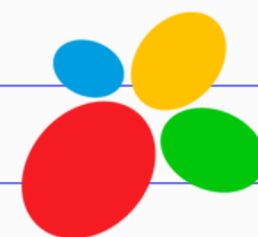



is a community-living project. As it is not a hostel, it is important to read the following information responsibly so that the time you spend there is enjoyable for you and for all.

Garaldea is an ecofeminist community that hosts social projects while fostering a deep connection with nature.

They promote diversity, autonomy, and trust through active listening and collective decision-making. Rooted in permaculture, intersectional feminism, and self-sufficiency, they create a safe space for learning, conflict resolution, and holistic personal growth.

### Accommodation Information:

- Bedrooms: Equipped with **bunk beds**, accommodating **3 to 5 people per room**.
- Bathrooms & Facilities: **Shared and self-organized**.
- Electricity:
  - **100% solar-powered and limited**.
  - Large electrical devices (e.g., hairdryers) are **not allowed**.
  - Occasional **power cuts** may occur.
  - **Limited water usage**.
- Connectivity:
  - Little to no internet connection.
  - Very limited or no phone signal.
